20-Week Abortion Ban: Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act



This would enact the sensible principle that our society should, protect children in the womb who can feel pain and many of whom are viable.

Quinnipiac University and CBS news found **56% - 60%** of Americans favor the 20-week ban.

Paid Leave: FAMILY Act



Parents who want to care for their unborn child with a terminal abnormality may need to take leave from work. Losing these wages can result in greater poverty for families and women.

Between **2/3** and **3/4** of women seeking abortion give as one major reason that they cannot afford having or caring for a baby.

Congress should pass a paid-leave law like the FAMILY Act to provide employees up to 12 weeks of partial pay for child and pregnancy causes.
